SOUS
sour cream, 1 teaspoon curry, 1/4 teaspoon salt and dash of pepper.
Break tuna into pieces and add. Heat slowly stirring often. Serve over hot rice.
Good served with a salad of drained, canned grapefruit sections and French dressing.

FISH FILLETS
1 pound package of frozen fish fillets—sole or perch
1/2 cup fresh ground pepper
2 tablespoons margarine
1 can frozen condensed cream of mushroom soup
1/4 cup Parmesan cheese
1 egg
Thaw fish fillets and arrange in buttered baking dish. Sprinkle with salt and pepper and dot with margarine.
Add about 2 tablespoons of sherry to thinned soup and spread over fish. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and paprika.
Bake at 425 degrees about 25 minutes, until fish flakes easily. Serve with lemon wedges.
Good with baked potatoes. During last 25 minutes of baking time, put fish in oven.
Good with lettuce and tomato salad topped with cottage cheese. Good with a light dash of oil and vinegar dressing.

HAM AND POTATOES
1/4 cup chopped green onions
1/4 cup chopped green peppers
2 cups diced ham
3 cups diced cooked potatoes
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup mayonnaise
1/2 pound sliced cheddar cheese

SKILLET MEAL
tablespoon instant minced onion
1/2 cup milk
1 1/2 pounds ground round (or hamburger)
1 slightly beaten egg
1/2 cup onion
2 teaspoons salt
1/2 cup fresh ground pepper
dash of two kitchen (bouquet)
1/2 cup water
1/2 ounce can spaghetti sauce with mushroom
1/2 ounce can kidney beans
Soak one and a half (five minutes); mix in ground beef, egg, salt, salt and pepper. Pound in a 10 inch skillet. Score into 6 wedges. Sprinkle lightly with kitchen bouquet to brown top.
Combine spaghetti sauce with beans and liquid. Pour over meat mixture. Simmer uncovered 30 or 40 minutes or until done to your liking.
Serve with thick sliced roasted French bread and tossed salad.
It would help if you had a pretty recipe, but it tastes just as good served from an old black iron.

TUNA CURRY
Cook 1/3 cup chopped onion, 1/4 cup chopped green pepper, 1/2 cup sliced mushrooms, 2 or 3 tablespoons of margarine oil tender but not brown. Stir in 1 cup

1 1/2 cups quick cake flour
3 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 cup sugar
1 egg
2 tablespoons melted shortening or vegetable oil
1 teaspoon lemon extract
You may add all dry ingredients. Break eggs into a 1 cup measuring cup, add shortening and fill cup with milk; pour into mixing bowl and add flour. Gradually add dry ingredients and beat until creamy. Turn into 2 greased 8 inch layer pans and bake in moderate oven at 375 degrees about 25 minutes.
Serve with brown sugar sauce or chocolate syrup from the can. You may also arrange sliced bananas between the layers and on top and serve with cup heavy cream, whipped, and sprinkled with 1/4 cup chopped walnuts or pecans. Serve while fresh!
