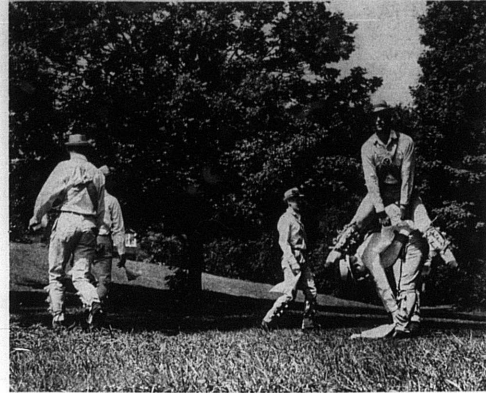
Mr. and Mrs. Stanley W. Caswell of Paris spent Sunday with Mr. and Mrs. H.A. Gaunce and family.
