LAMB STEW
2 quarts of water
2 pounds of more lamb shoulder
1 large onion
1 green pepper, chopped
1/2 cup of rice
1 tsp. salt
1 1/4 cup. black pepper or about 1/2 cup. red pepper
1/4 cup. 4 pepper corners
1/4 cup. oil
1 1/2 cup. canned tomatoes
1 cup. canned peas
Remove excess fat from shoulder. Brown meat in hot water; add onion, green pepper, rice and seasoning. Simmer slowly until tender. Add canned tomatoes and peas and cook about 10 minutes or until your choice, the soup to serve a good tart fruit salad. Remember the most important thing of all is to purchase fresh.

As I write this the sun is shining, wind blowing and I can see the green hills of the Kentucky landscape out of the ground. Oh! Spring-I hope, my spirits may be soaring. My publication day but right now my mind is on spring and that is the means Kentucky spring lamb.

BROILED LAMB CHOPS
Select single or double chops of uniform thickness from loin, ribs or shoulder; remove "fleece" or outer skin and excess fat and wipe with damp cloth. You will find the loin chops have more meat and are also more tender and have less fat than shoulder chops. Place chops on lightly greased rack of broiler pan. If chops are 1 1/2 inches thick it usually takes about 25 minutes. Turn chops occasionally while cooking. Serve with mint sauce or a very tart jelly.

WELSH RABBIT
1 cup thin white sauce
1/4 teaspoon dry mustard
2 cups (1/2 pound) fairly sharp cheddar cheese
alices of hot buttered toast
Prepare sauce, add mustard and cheese and cook over boiling water until done. Melted and mixture until smooth, stirring constantly. Serve on toast. Should serve four.

LARDINE
Now lets branch out - LARDINE RABBIT - Use the above recipe and arrange strands on buttered hot toast; place under hot broiler for 2 to 3 minutes. Pour hot rabbit over slices and serve at once. Add salt and ginger. Dissolve solids in hot water and add alternately with flour. Heat well.

TUNA FISH RABBIT
Prepare rabbit using 1/4 cup grated cheese, reduce salt to 1/8 teaspoon and add 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce for mustard. Add small can of tuna and cook until thoroughly heated.

TOMATO RABBIT
Substitute 1 can tomato soup for 1 cup white sauce; add 1 cup grated cheese, 1 small p/c chopped onion, green pepper, 1 minced green pepper and cook until cheese is melted. Serve on toast or hot biscuits.

PLAIN CHEESE RABBIT
Cut one pound cooking cheese very fine. Place in heavy pan, add 1/8 teaspoon mustard, 3/4 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce, 1/2 cup of tomato. When cheese begins to melt, slowly add 1 cup beer, stirring until it becomes absorbed. Serve with Frenchbread or biscuits.

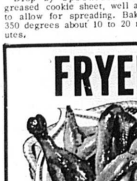

GINGER SNAPS
1/2 cup shortening or butter (1 use margarine)
1 cup brown sugar
1 cup molasses
6 cups sifted flour



GINGER DROP COOKIES
1 cup brown sugar
1/4 cup molasses
1 cup shortening
1/2 cup flour
1 cup hot water
2 eggs
1 teaspoon ginger
1 teaspoon soda
1/4 teaspoon salt
Cream shortening, gradually beat in sugar, molasses and eggs. Add salt and ginger. Dissolve solids in hot water and add alternately with flour. Heat well.

GINGER RABBIT
Drop by spoonfuls on well greased cookie sheet, well apart to allow for spreading. Bake at 350 degrees about 10 to 20 minutes.
