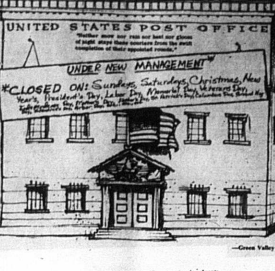
tell us our mailing costs are going up 14% in the next five months. The first-class letter rate is to rise from 6¢ to 8¢ in May.
