Department of Agriculture today announced that a mail referendum among wool and lamb producers will be held June 7 through 18 to determine their approval or disapproval of a new agreement with the American Sheep Producers Council (ASPC). The agreement provides for the Secretary to withhold a part of producer's wool payments on 1971-72 marketing. The payment deductions would be used by the Council to finance advertising and promotion programs for wool and lamb.
