## 350 Volunteers Cleanup Gorge

A small army of about 350 conservation-minded volunteers invaded Red River Gorge Nov. 6 to pick up tons of litter from trails, roadsides and riverbanks.

The cleanup was sponsored by the Sierra Club which covers Kentucky and Tennessee.

Volunteers included Boy Scouts, teachers, students, outdoorsmen and even whole families.

They warmed up and down steep banks along narrow creeks and even descended 130-foot Chimney Top Rock to collect litter left by the thousands of tourists who have flocked to the gorge in recent years.

Oscar Gerald, Sierra Club conservation chairman, said the project's objectives were twofold.

"The first is to get the area clean, of course," he said. "But, secondly, we want to help bring people out of the problems involving litter, waste disposal and the incalculable attitudes of many of our fellow men."

This year's haul of rubbish was somewhat less than the 15 tons collected last fall when the first cleanup was held.

The most littered area was a ditch along Ky. 77 near the Zada Tunnel where plastic cans, bottles and other junk were scattered.
