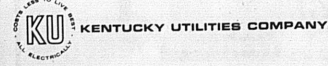

 Seat Vacant, 6th Congressional District, Kentucky.
 Equal rights for men and women constitutional amendment which reads as follows:
 Sec. 1 Equality of Rights under the law shall not be abridged by the United States or by any state on account of sex.
 Sec. 2 The Congress shall enforce this legislation, the provisions of this article.
 Sec. 3 This Amendment shall take effect two years after the date of ratification.
