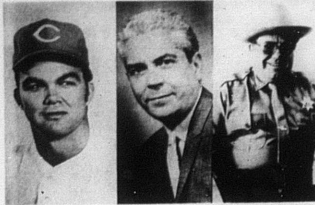


Kay's Kitchen -- By Kay Fisher



W.B. Theme of the promotion in Carlisle will be "Depend on the Dodge boys".

As you know I always welcome recipes to this column. This week I have three from interested readers. And I want them to know I appreciate anyone taking the time to write out a recipe in these busy days. Both of these sound good. The bread one baked in an unusual manner.

FRUIT COCKTAIL CAKE
2 cups sifted cake flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
2 1/2 cups white sugar
1/2 cup brown sugar
1 - 16 ounce can of fruit cocktail and juice
Mix sugars and eggs in bowl. Add flour and soda and cocktail. Beat by hand for three minutes. Pour into buttered 8" by 12" pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 to 50 minutes. Good served warm or cold.
(Note: this one you mix and bake in same dish.)

LEMON SURPRISE

1/4 cup flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
2 eggs, separated
1/4 cup lemon juice
1 cup milk
Sift flour with sugar and salt into casserole. Beat egg yolks; add lemon juice and milk. Blend into dry ingredients. Beat egg whites and fold in.
Place casserole in a pan of water. Bake at 350 degrees for 45 to 50 minutes. Good served warm or cold.
(Note: this one you mix and bake in same dish.)

GINGERBREAD

1/3 cup of fat
2/3 cup boiling water
1 cup sorghum
1 egg
2 1/4 cups flour
2 teaspoons soda
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon cumin
1/2 teaspoon ginger
1/4 teaspoon cloves
Melt fat in water, the recipe continues as, add sorghum, well-beaten egg, and dry ingredients mixed and sifted together. Bake in oven at 350 degrees.

SORGHUM NUT PIE
2 tablespoons butter
2 tablespoons flour
1 1/4 cups sorghum
2 tablespoons vinegar
1/2 teaspoon salt

Just tell her whose number you want. Then write it down so you'll have it next time, and dial it direct. Just dial "1", the area code (if different from your own), and the number. Next time you need an out-of-town telephone number, remember, 555-1212. It's one little number that's worth a thousand phone books.

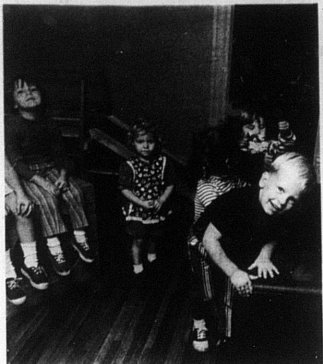

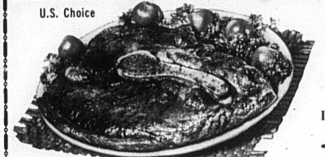
