### Expanded camping made available for Girl Scouts

An expanded camping opportunity for Girl Scouts in the county has been opened by the Wilderness Road Girl Scout Council for two established camps. It will operate this summer.

The council announced this week that one-week sessions would be opened in the fall and winter months in the fifth and sixth grades who have not previously attended a Girl Scout established camp. Previously the one-week sessions were open only to younger Scouts.

The sessions will be held July 30 thru Aug. 4, and Aug. 6 thru Aug. 11 at both Camp Judy and Camp Cardinal. The registration fee for these one-week sessions is \$35.00 for Scouts and \$40.00 for non-Scouts.

Camp Judy Lane is located near Frenchburg in the Daniel Boone National Forest and Camp Cardinal near Carter Cave State Park. Meanwhile, the Council reported that registration for one and two-week sessions at the two camps will begin. The registration began March 15.

However, Scouts planning to attend were advised to register as soon as possible and to list first, second and third choices of sessions since some already are filled.

Sessions are being held from July 18 through Aug. 31. Registration information may be obtained from the Girl Scout Council office, 1000 West Main Street, Lexington.
