State expands firemen training

State Fire Marshal Warren Southworth says a recent program for firemen is "one of the best things to happen to Kentucky in the field of prevention for some years."

The 20-hour course, offered through the Department of Education, provides firemen with both field and classroom training. It is the first state to offer an annual fire training school without charge.

The first state to pay the expenses of firemen from each fire department at the fire school, Lexington, Ky., was the first to do so. It is now being done in other parts of the state.

Bob Pike, Vocational Education coordinator for the expanded program, said staff strength still is low, but with the experience gained through the first six months of operation, that problem may be partially solved.

Pike has given each instructor a Sept. 15 deadline to contact every fire department in his respective region. He will be able to schedule a training course.

Kirstenman, Aid and Civil Defense coordinator for the fire department, said that the fire department may receive the course under state request. All fire departments in Kentucky meet this requirement, he added.

So as to have courses held in the fire department, instructors may be able to adapt themselves to teach the course with whatever material is on hand.

Although all fire departments will be able to handle the course, those with separate training facilities or officers will be better equipped to handle their own training with supervision from the fire prevention coordinator.

The program will provide instruction in proper care of hoses and how to keep equipment operation in good condition. Fire-fighting tactics.

Pike said that next year, instructors will review what courses have been given to the firemen and make adjustments as needed. There are that can express their

curriculum used for the course. Although two instructors have worked in the field for several years and some of the new full-time additions were previously hired as part-time help, the coordinators themselves are attending classes, Pike said.

"We have two students at the University of Kentucky and another at Murray State studying technical courses," he said. "This is the first time we've been implementing it. We must get the proper information from the curriculum studios to do the job."
