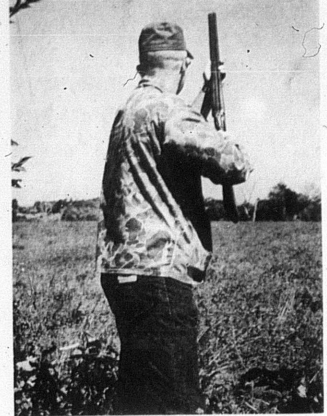


# Dove population up biologist says



Frankfort—Kentucky hunters can expect a good dove harvest again this year, according to Dan Russell, chief farm game biologist in the Department of Fish and Wildlife. Russell says that this year's dove population should be slightly higher over last year.

Russell notes that the dove is one of the most popular game birds in Kentucky. The dove season runs from Sept. 1 through Oct. 31 and then reopens Dec. 1 and continues through Sept. 9.

Sierra fields with power lines bordering or crossing them are usually good bets for doves. Hunters are reminded to always ask permission of the landowner before entering or hunting on private lands.
