Apply now for new grower tobacco quotas

Applications for 1973 new grower tobacco quotas are now being accepted at the Nicholas County ASCS Office, according to an announcement made by the Waggoner, Chairman of the County ASCS Committee.

The Chairman pointed out that in order to qualify for new grower quotas, all of the requirements must be met. Some of the requirements for the application are: experience of the last year on a farm with quota. He must own the farm and be the farm operator. He must not own or operate another farm with a tobacco quota. He must have readily available equipment and other facilities necessary to grow the crop. He must expect to obtain more than 50 per cent of his current year (1973) income from farming. This would include estimated returns from home gardens, livestock and their products, poultry or other products produced for home consumption or other use on the farm. This would not include any estimated returns from the requested quota. Special provisions are available for low income applicants.

Any person who is interested in applying for a new grower quota may obtain additional information and the application forms from their County ASCS Office. The deadline for filing applications is Feb. 15.

Mr. Waggoner said, "The lists are voluntary. Farmers who are short on pounds or have too many pounds can have their names put on the bulletin board." The purpose of the lists is to try to get people wanting to lease tobacco AWAY from their farm together with people who have too much tobacco and want to lease TO their farm.

The lists are on display on the bulletin board of the County Office. Farmers who want to lease tobacco call (289-3267) or visit the office. If they want, they may have their name placed on the list telling how many pounds they want to lease and how they may be contacted.

The Chairman pointed out that it was very important that all tobacco sold on a farm's marketing card must have been grown on that farm. Trading, swapping, selling or giving away tobacco to be sold on another farm's marketing card is against the law. Leasing of pounds should be used to take care of any shortage or overage of pounds. If the lease is done properly, it will not effect any quotas for 1973.

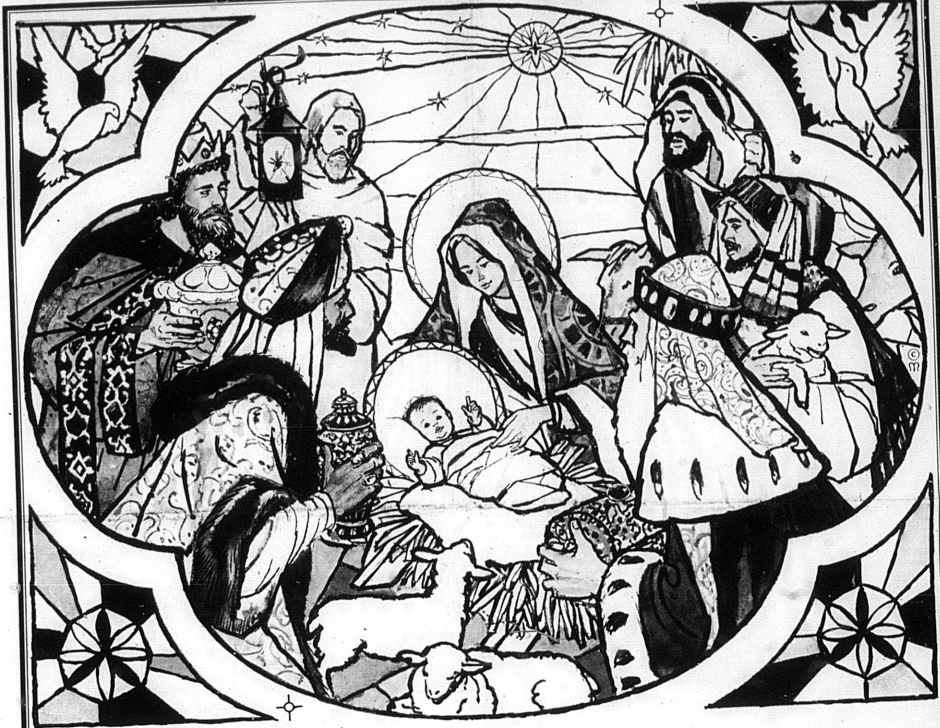
