TOPRESS WITH NITROGEN

Topdress small grains with nitrogen now is being urged by farm leaders. The ideal time to topdress is in late February or early March, on dry days or days when the ground is frozen. Nitrogen increases yields by increasing the number and size of tillers and by making the plants apply top to late in the spring the ratio of leaf area to stem will be increased, causing too much vegetative growth and late, uneven maturity.

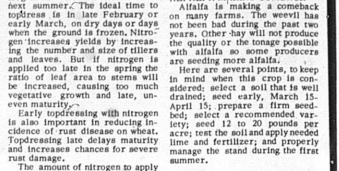

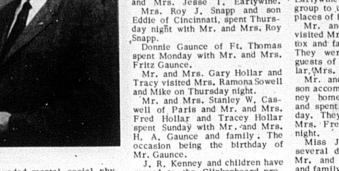
