## A question of quality How good is Ky. food service

You're traveling along an Interstate highway in Kentucky, and you've got the hunger. You see a town or familiar byway "gas, food and lodging" sign and make a quick right turn to seek out a place to eat. At 62 off-ramp 90 or so extra, you'll find a restaurant before traveling more than a half mile. But how good a place will it be? Will it be "clean"? Can you be guaranteed that the food meets quality standards? Just how good is food service of Interstate exchanges anyway? And how good is food service in Kentucky, generally?

A survey made possible by a federal grant is likely to answer those questions, says E.P. Coyner, D.V.M., director of both the survey and the State Department of Health's Food Service Program. The \$39,800 grant from the Food and Drug Administration, U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, specifies that food service establishments in 20 per cent of Kentucky's counties be surveyed. Restaurants located within one-half mile of selected inter-

## 97 educators attend first Cooperative Council meeting

Moves toward regionalization, better communication and emphasis on vocational and career education were called for today by approximately 97 educators attending the first meeting of the newly created Cooperative Council on Education.

The council, composed of local school superintendents, principals, teachers, counselors, and representatives from higher education and other educational agencies, was created by State Superintendent of Public Instruction Dr. Lyman V. Gieger in an effort to "find out what the leadership role of the State Department of Education should be in order to meet the needs of the public."

Following an unprecedented move to involve "grass roots" educators in decision making, the council members met in small sub-committee sessions, reviewed and evaluated many of the state's current educational problems and programs, and recommended the following action:

Regionalization of state services, with local offices serviced by local personnel cooperating with the State Department in areas ranging from curricula to public relations. The council members felt the regionalization move would allow for "better service to our students" in the embryonic stage, the regionalization idea would combine 10 to 15 counties in each

## Economic Stabilization Questions and Answers

**Internal Revenue Service**

Q—Rent controls do not apply to commercial, nonresidential property, but in general they do apply to existing residential property. How is property which is land both for commercial and residential purposes to be treated? For example, a building which is rented for office space and apartments?

A—Yes. Both large and small firms may be subject to spot-checking by the IRS to determine if they are complying with Price Control Administration regulations.

Q—Can an auto dealer try to charge for equipment on a car that was previously handled as a standard car?

A—No. This would be a violation of the price controls.

Q—I know that raw agricultural products are exempt from price controls, but how do you know what is considered to be a "raw agricultural product"?

A—Agricultural products which retain their original physical form and have not been processed are exempt from price controls. Processed agricultural products, namely, those which have been canned, frozen, slaughtered, milled, or otherwise changed in their physical form, are not exempt. Packaging is not considered a processing activity. Thus, while fresh potatoes, packaged or not, are exempt from controls, frozen french fries are not; white live
