It is so nice to have a "gourmet" column once in a while, particularly when you know the recipes to be extra good. Too, this week they are one of my favorite fruits, and have been tried by Mrs. Margie Wilson, Home Demonstration Agent, my guest.

LATTICE TOP RHUBARB PIE

2 eggs
1 1/2 cups sugar
1/3 cup flour
1 tablespoon grated orange rind
1/4 teaspoon salt
4 cups cut-up rhubarb
2 tablespoons butter

Make pastry of 2 cups sifted flour, 1 teaspoon salt, 2/3 cup shortening and 3 to 5 tablespoons cold water. Mix, press dough to bottom of pie pan. Roll remaining half same thickness and cut in half-inch strips. Turn rhubarb mixture into bottom pastry, add butter, and weave pastry strips to form crisscross lattice top. Trim edge, place strip of dough around edge and seal. Bake in hot oven, 450 degrees for 15 minutes, then reduce heat to 350 degrees and bake 25 minutes longer.

RHUBARB CRISP

4 cups chopped rhubarb
1/2 cup cinnamon
1/2 teaspoon salt
3/4 cup flour
1 1/2 cups sugar

Place the rhubarb in 6x10-inch baking dish and sprinkle with cinnamon and salt. Mix the flour, sugar and butter and sprinkle over rhubarb. Bake at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Serve warm with whipped cream or cream. Serves 6 to 8.

RHUBARB SURPRISE PIE

For crust, mix together 1 cup flour, 1 teaspoon baking powder, 1/2 teaspoon salt. Cut in 2 tablespoons shortening. Add 1 beaten

egg and 2 tablespoons milk. Press into greased pie pan.
For filling put 3 cups chopped rhubarb on bottom of crust. Sprinkle with 1 cup sugar and 1 package strawberry gelatin (raspberry may be used).
For topping combine 1 cup sugar, 1/2 cup flour, 1/4 cup butter. Sprinkle on top of filling.
Place in a 350 degree preheated oven for 40 to 50 minutes or until rhubarb is tender, when knife is inserted. Remove, cool and refrigerate.
