Hatcheries and packers must meet July 1 deadline under new law

Hatchery operators and egg packers have until July 1, 1972, to register with the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) under the Egg Products Inspection Act.

Under the second phase, AMS egg officials said, hatcheries will be inspected to assure that incubator rejects are being crushed, destroyed or destroyed, and labeled according to procedures.

Those who have not received their registration forms should contact the regional director, AMS officials emphasized.
