FRANKFORT—Before the 1974 Legislature convenes the Kentucky Revenue Department should have all property in the state assessed at 100 per cent, or as near as humanly possible, of fair cash value.

This effort has been going on since 1965 when the Court Appraisers handed down its landmark decision that all property should be assessed at 100 per cent.

When the court handed down its ruling a special session of the legislature was called and passed the rollback law.

If the Supreme Court upholds this theory, schools will have to finance on a statewide basis and upon a school district basis as presently used.

For example, a man with a \$10,000 lot in Los Angeles owns a blue color lot in West Covina district pays more school taxes to a district than he pays \$600 per child.

If he owned the same house in the affluent area he would pay only \$20 in taxes to school district that spends \$800 per child.

The federal revenue sharing program also depends upon what effect it made.

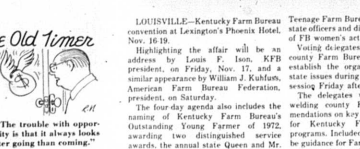
