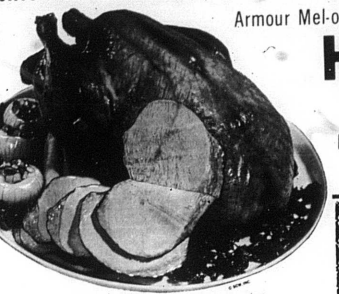

## Scalope Oysters
