Local artists donate drawings of Nicholas County landmarks

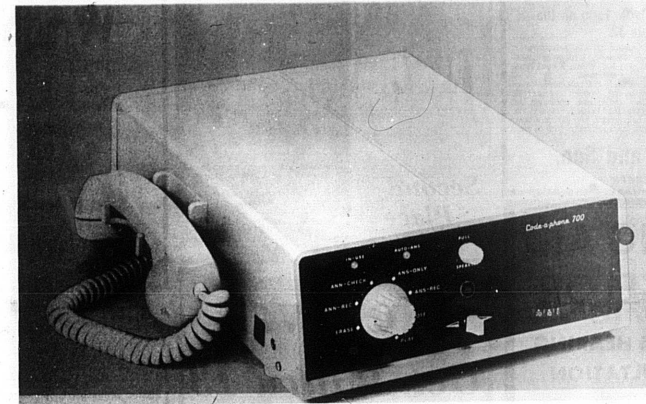
For the first time the Carlisle Junior Woman's Club sponsored a calendar project with Nicholas County landmarks as its theme. This is the first time the club women have sponsored an art contest open to all residents of Nicholas County. The club supplied a list of 25 suggested sites, and 17 entries were submitted to the judge, Mrs.

Denna Standford, art instructor at Fleming County High School. Twelve pen and ink drawings were chosen for the calendar. The winning sketch of the Nicholas County Health Department was drawn by Miss Karen Wagener, 12, a student at Nicholas County Elementary. Four Nicholas County High School students had drawings in-

cluded in the calendar. They are Miss Cheryl Lowe, Carlisle United Methodist Church; Miss Ann Marshall, the Carlisle Christian Church and Michael Rawlings, Nicholas County Library; all freshmen. The other artists were: Mrs. Merolyn Sams, the Stone Barn on the Forest Retreat Farm; Mrs. Joan Noll, the Henry Thompson Home, built in 1785; Mrs. Pam Anderson, Blue Licks Museum; and Earl Marshall, a horse scene at Forest Retreat Farm. Mrs. Gayle Vanlandingham will have her drawings of the Old Concord Church and the Daniel Boone Cabin in the cal-

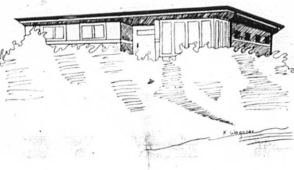

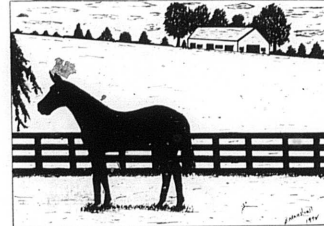

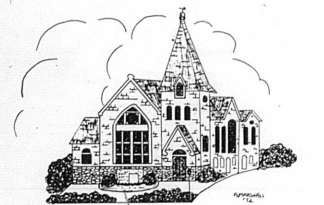

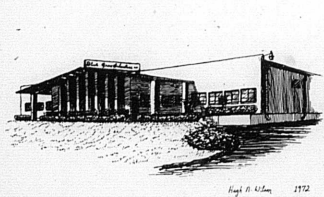

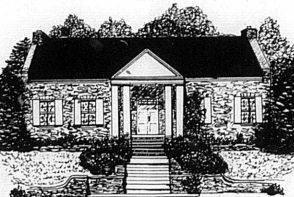

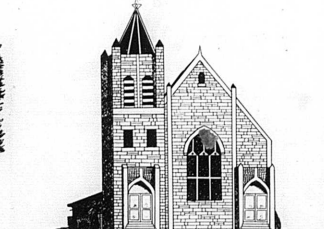
