If you are seedling in small grains, legumes or grasses this fall, you will be money ahead if you use the best seed you can buy. The small grain operation, every dollar spent raising the crop goes for the seed, it is low yielding seed results in a poor stand, much of the other money used in producing the crop is wasted.

Using high quality seed is the best way to insure maximum yields and returns from your crops. Good seed costs a few cents per acre more than "bargain seed" but is likely to return extra dollars per acre at harvest time.

The seed label provides information on several important factors involved in seed quality. These factors include:

- 1. Kind and variety. It is important to select the kind and variety of seed which is best adapted to your area and which will give you the highest yield potential and disease resistance.
- 2. Mechanical purity, or the percentage of crop seed compared to the percentage of objectionable weed seed, other crop seed and inert material.
- 3. Germination. High germination is necessary for seedlings to develop into healthy, vigorous plants.
- 4. Adaptation and origin. Seed is more likely to be adapted to the area where it was grown, so locally produced seed is likely to be superior to imported seed.

The best assurance of getting high quality seed is to buy certified seed. Certified seed bears a blue tag. It has been field inspected and accepted for general purity and has met minimum standards for germination, pure seed, and freedom from noxious weeds and certain diseases.

SILAGE-MAKING TIME AGAIN

Reminders for making silage: 1. Cut when 30-40% dry matter, hard dent stage (past physiological maturity).

2. Chop it fine. 3. Mix it well. 4. Exclude air. Silage is excellent feed, but it is not inexpensive. It should be fed with protein supplement to growing calves for best results. Plan to use upright silos and equipment more than once a year. Each filling, lowers storage cost.

McCarthy said one insurance company doing business in Pennsylvania and Kentucky recently wrote: "They didn't reduce the annual premium," he explained. "That they increased the cash value of the policy by 14 per cent, thus reducing the cost of protection.
