LAMB SHISH KABOBS

4 pound lamb shoulder, boned 2 pounds seasoned meat-tenderizer 1/2 cup salad oil 1 1/2 cup lemon juice 1 tablespoon vinegar 1/2 cup garlic, minced or crushed 1/2 teaspoon crushed mint leaves 1/4 cup dry white wine (I buy 1 mean not a sweet wine) 1/4 cup honey 1/2 cup brown sugar 1/8 teaspoon Tabasco (just a good pinch) 1 medium size can mushrooms 1 medium size can tomatoes Cut lamb into 1 1/2 inch cubes. Trim off excess fat, and sprinkle at room temperature for 30 or 40 minutes.

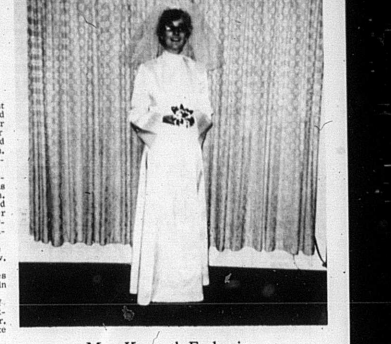
