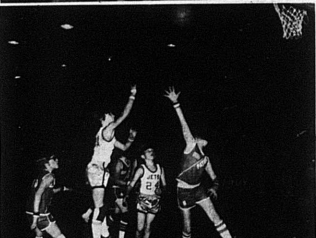

### High school Vo-Ag students study soil map and land use

James Brumagen, the Vocational Agriculture teacher at Nicholas County High School has been teaching his Senior students land use. Willmer Halcomb, District Conservationist with the U.S. Soil Conservation Service assisted him in explaining soil maps and land use classifications. All the students had a soils map of their farm or an adjacent farm that they were acquainted with. It was explained to the students what some of the factors were that determined land classification. It was pointed out that some of the things that enter into land classification are: soil depth, wetness, droughtiness, slope, stoney, erosion, composition and many other things. The Soil Conservation Service considers eight different land capability classes. Class I and being land suited for row crops each year with good farming practices. Class II land being used for row crops about half of the time. Class III land can be used for row crops one year out of three. Class IV land, if used, is for row crops. Class VIII land is wet or rocky and will support only recreation purposes or some forms of wildlife.

Some of the high school students have indicated that they want to farm for a living after getting out of school. Understanding land classification would be a great help to a young farmer buying a farm.
