## Jackets overcome St. Pat for second time

### Hazel Green whips Nicholas

The big mountain boys from Hazel Green, led by hot shot scoring ace John Beasley, threatened to blow Nicholas back out of the hills in a hurry Saturday night. The Jackets, minus steady playmaker Doug Jones, were down 31-10 barely into the second quarter.

Jones received a badly wrenched knee in Friday's win over Maysville. St. Patrick's coach, Bill Anderson, "That hurts," lamented Anderson, who quickly added that "Doug's been playing some pretty good ball."

Jones' absence was clearly felt as his teammates definitely were not sharp early in the game, missing several easy shots, besides having terrific troubles defensively against a club that starts three boys 6'2" or better. "That's not too good," said Anderson, "they all look big against us."

Trailing by 21, Victor Bromagen, Wallace Edwards, and Ricky Hicks came up off the bench in time to whittle Hazel Green's lead to 12 at the half.

Before the second half started, Beasley had 14 points, and teammates Carl Wilson and Bill Stinnet had ten and eight respectively. The third quarter showed little promise as Beasley and Co. upped their lead four more points, 64-4.

Then came the fireworks. Nicholas became an awesome assault on its offensive boards and started shooting like they'd always wanted to. When the smoke cleared, the boys in blue had amassed an incredible 15 field goals out one free throw in outscoring their host 31-22. But 22 points were quite enough for Hazel Green as the Blue Jacket tide was suppressed in the end, 42-75.

Doug Barber shot extremely well in the second half as he had eight points and Gerald Hatton's 12 totaled 20 of the County's 31 points scored in the big fourth quarter. Hatton was very impressive in the rebounding department as he and his

teammates held the taller Hazel Green five to a virtual stand-off on the boards. He and Doug Fryman snared 11 and 10 rebounds, respectively, for 21 of the team's 42 rebounds. 24 of these were offensive as Nicholas showed little trouble in getting the second and third shots.

Strangely enough the Bluejackets were beaten at the foul line where they managed just five of 12 while Hazel Green could be 20 for 20 for 80%. The Jackets had the advantage in field goals hitting 31 of 46 while the hosts were shooting 21 of 84.

Two free throws each by Hatton and Victor Bromagen put Nicholas on top for the first time of the evening, 18-17. Then teamleader and center Shoemaker, who had been staging a momentous battle of the boards with jumping-jack Hatton, went to war. Shoemaker cleared the boards and put in two rebound shots as his club outscored the visitors 10-2 in a two minute span.
