

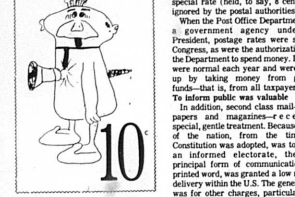
Overheat now, freeze later
