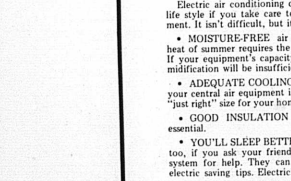

MEDICINE CHEST

Are X-rays dangerous? - K.M. Exposure to large amounts of X-rays, like exposure to gamma rays, can increase the incidence of leukemia, cancer, and cause damage to reproductive cells. There is some evidence that X-ray examinations of the chest, particularly in the area of the lungs, are among their offspring. It is a good idea to have an X-ray examination made for proper medical care far greater than the risk of examination.

Is there any new medicine for psoriasis (the skin)? I take L. Dreyer's O.M.C.

Dreyer's is the newest medication for treating your condition. If it is not working for you, then it's time for another visit to your doctor. He may wish to try another medicine, or dosage, or he may wish to add additional medicine to what you are already taking. These medicines - like nuts and bolts for machinery - have to be adjusted to be more compatible with your body. Let your doctor make the adjustments for you. Can you tell me where I can buy such things which are low in cost? - H.P.

Can you be breathy tired indicate how much alcohol is in your blood?

The deep lung contains a concentration of alcohol which directly correlates with the amount of alcohol in your blood stream. The breathalyzer test requires the subject to blow through a tube into a measuring chamber. The subject must blow as long and as hard as possible on the instrument. The resulting value shows and extracts the last end (deep lung air) blown into the chamber.
