Although a Morgan county farmer, Earl M. Leach, of Ezel, was recorded as the one-month registrant recently, there are still over a million eligible voters who have not registered.

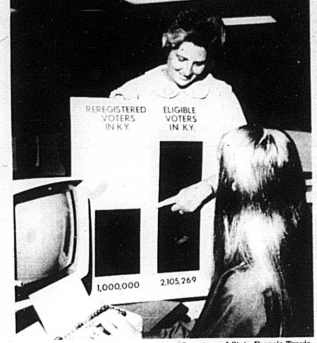
Kentuckians who have not registered, Mrs. Stovall asserted that "as the Sept. 24 deadline is by statute law, absolutely no extension can be granted."
