KEEP FERTILITY RECORDS

You should keep a record system for each field you have in production on your farm. That is the advice of Extension specialists at the University of Kentucky College of Agriculture. The record should contain the results of soil test, the amount of lime and fertilizer applied each year, and the crop grown each year along with the yields produced. You should plan to test the soil in each field an average of every four years. Annual sampling is to be preferred for high-cash crops and double crop production. Only with such a record system can you keep track of soil test values over a period of years. You need this information to make wise decisions on fertilizer investments.
