household or job-and-homebased rotations after attending the annual Homemakers conference last week in the UK campus in Lexington, Nicholas county women are reflecting on some of the highlights they learned there. Aside from attending to the regular business of their Kentucky Extension Homemakers Association, they heard from UK administrators, toured University farms, attended a special workshop-like learning session, heard from two out-of-state speakers, and were filled in on some interesting new statistics about the changing membership profile of their organization since 1962.

More than one-fifth live in rural areas, but not on a farm. Slightly over four-fifths are farm homemakers. Another fact concerning the working wife and mother: More than one-fourth of the Extension Homemakers are employed outside the home, either full or part-time.

Extension Homemakers are getting younger all the time, or so it seems from the survey, which turned up almost 4,000 under 30 years of age. At one time almost all the members were over 30. More than 1,000 fall in the 30-40 age group. Many old-time members are still active in their local clubs, too, with the exception of a few who have died.

Speaking to the conference theme of "Education Today, Action Tomorrow," Dr. Mack Wayne Craig defined teaching by quoting UK President Joseph Mathis, who called it "gathering sticks and building fires." If children are deeply enough inspired by parents and teachers and life itself, he said, they will keep those fires of knowledge, caring and action burning for future generations. Dr. Craig is dean of David Lipscomb College, Nashville, Tenn.

Special small-group learning sessions were held on the following topics: Can You Afford to be Sick?, Community Affairs. You Can Make a Difference, Opened Doors for Membership, Information for Action, Moral Pollution, and In The Market Place. According to Marie H. Wilson, Nicholas County Extension agent for some economic areas, a 1973 survey questionnaire answered by 97 percent of the KEHA membership, gives some interesting new facts about the women who belong.

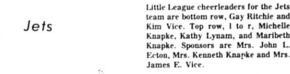

## KSP radio technicians keep busy

**FRANKFORT—**Like a giant spider web, the state police radio communications network spans Kentucky, giving police officers in base stations and radios to motorists.

That complicated network represents the nerve center for state police operations. Its proper function hinges on weather patterns, abilities of state troopers and radio dispatchers to call a radio trooper to the right place at the right time.

That most important, the indispensable skills of 10 state police radio technicians.

"Making sure that 750 trooper radios, transmission towers and other equipment used in good condition are just a few responsibilities undertaken by our radio technicians," Capt. Felix Atwood, commander of the State Police Communications Unit, said.

Atwood said that seven radio technicians are currently assigned to the 10 state police posts. Besides making major repairs on transmission towers damaged by lightning, they are installing new radio equipment at post headquarters, each man also is responsible for the daily operation of about 100 trooper vehicle radio units.

Like state troopers, technicians are on call on a 24-hour-per basis and judge their work schedules to meet daily demands.

A list of technical activities for one month indicated that six of the technicians traveled over 11,000 miles to fix or install thousands of dollars worth of equipment.

One technician, Richard Graves, assigned to the Bowling Green and Henderson posts, traveled 2,622 miles to repair 17 trooper vehicle radios, 13 transmission towers and three vehicle radar units.

In addition, he also overhauled the Bowling Green post's entire radio set-up to correct "high voltage" problems caused by weather-induced power failures.

The state police technician force boasts at least 15 years of experience per man. All but one are listed as senior radio technicians, and one veteran technician claims state police officer job.

Heavy casualties suggest that at least one additional technician is needed.

"We are on record with the state personal office as wanting one more technician," Atwood said.

"It is obvious here for long and shorted efforts have been unavailing," said Atwood, who himself served as a radio technician from 1951 to 1967.

The effort to hire an additional technician apparently is hampered by the fact that the state has no radio technician schools.

"We are going to look for a private person, a qualified applicant must possess a Federal Communications Commission (FCC) second-class commercial license, have at least two years experience in related work and a high school graduate.

"We can't claim that a radio technician gets rich working for the state police," Atwood said. "But, we can offer him a great challenge to join a dedicated team of professionals."
