\$467,537 in back wages restored to employees

Some \$467,537 in back wages was restored to 1,919 employees in 159 establishments in the last half of 1973 as a result of investigations made by the U.S. Labor Department's Wage and Employment Standards Administration. The U.S. Labor Department's Wage and Employment Standards Administration reported that 1,917 workers received \$467,537 in back wages due them because employers had failed to comply with the minimum wage, stirred every time a portion is removed from the barrel.
