Proclamation Youth charged in fatal shooting

WHEREAS, respiratory disease represent about half of the chronic illnesses of children and account for as much as 10 percent of the time spent by pediatricians in treatment; and WHEREAS, lung-damaging diseases affect more than 6 million children in the United States; and WHEREAS, the most tragic respiratory disease in children is Cystic Fibrosis, an inherited biochemical disorder which occurs once in approximately fifteen hundred births, and

WHEREAS, at this time there is no control, despite advance in treatment, for this inherited disease; and WHEREAS, the National Cystic Fibrosis Research Foundation is supporting research to find a control for Cystic Fibrosis and improved care for all children with lung-damaging disease; and WHEREAS, the week of Sept. 8-14 has been designated as Breath of Life Week in the City of Carlisle to elicit public support in the fight against Cystic Fibrosis and other serious lung diseases in children;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, That I, William Powers, acting under and with the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the city of Carlisle, Kentucky, do hereby proclaim the week of Sept. 8-14 as Breath of Life Week and urge the citizens of our community to join with the National Cystic Fibrosis Research Foundation in its humanitarian task.

Although Cystic Fibrosis, the most serious lung-damaging disease, is still incurable, the average life expectancy of children afflicted has been increased from infancy to the late teens, and many patients now live into young adulthood. These great strides of progress are due to earlier diagnosis

and improved methods of treatment, which have developed from a better understanding of the disease. In addition, the treatment programs which aid C/F patients are proving very effective in alleviating the suffering and other curing children with severe asthma, chronic bronchitis, bronchiectasis and a condition sometimes called "childhood emphysema."

"Sadly, we know more today than we ever before, but we still have a long way to go before we've conquered C.F.," said Mrs. Anderson. "Every dollar that is donated to the Life Campaign means better health and a brighter future for youngsters struggling for the 'breath of life.'"

Kendall wins Rifle Crown

Presly Kendall a native of Carlisle, stationed at Ft. McPherson Ga., firing near perfect scores during final round action, won the 1974 National Shooting Rifle Pro- Championships last Tuesday with a four-day score of 4,390 out of a possible 4,600.

Kendall, the second three-time winner of the event, defeated Dennis Dingman, an Army Reserve major from Sioux Falls, S.D., by two points. Kendall, an active Army major, fired a final day 1,596 out of a possible 1,600. Dingman posted a perfect 600 points for each of Tuesday's four matches.

Dingman's four-day score was 4,388. Tom Whitaker of Belmont, Calif., finished third in the overall scoring and captured high civilian honors with a four-day score of 4,386, one point ahead of Army Maj. Lonnie Wigger of Carter, Mont.

Wigger was the defending champion and Whitaker a former national champion. Kendall and Wigger will be members of the United States team to the 1975 World Shooting Championships of the International Shooting Union. The championships, scheduled for Switzerland and this summer, will attract more than 1,300 shooters from 80 nations.
