Pre-Vacation Checklist
Just before the family leaves on vacation, there always seems to be a multitude of details to take care of. To help you remember some of these easily-forgotten tasks, so you can have a more enjoyable and less worrisome vacation, here's a pre-vacation checklist.

First, there are some precautions that will help you make sure your vehicle will be cared for and safe while you are away.

Call your local police department when you will leave and how long you will be away. Cancel all deliveries, such as milk, laundry, cleaning, and newspapers. Have a neighbor or post office hold all mail until you return.

Leave a key with a neighbor. Ask him to periodically check your house and pick up all circulars and handbills left in your porch. Arrange to have a friend mow the lawn when necessary. Store all valuables in a safe place.

Arrange for care of pets and houseplants.

Don't leave perishable foods in the refrigerator; set the refrigerator dial to low. Make sure all appliances are turned off. Unplugging appliances is not necessary but taking this precaution, too, won't hurt anything.

Preserve the normal appearance of your home. Don't pull the shades or blinds. Connect a lamp to an automatic timer that will turn on lights inside and outside the house each evening and turn them off again in the morning. Blackout curtains and air vents should be closed and a restraining rod in glass doors and windows. Check and lock all porch, basement and garage doors with dead-bolt locks.

Here are some suggestions for making travel more pleasant for the entire family.

Check the car to be sure it's in good running condition. If you will be towing a trailer, make sure it meets all safety requirements. Check your spare tire; make sure your flashlight is in working condition, and be sure to take along flares, first aid kit, fire extinguisher, and tow chain.

Be sure all members of the family who will be driving take along their driver's licenses and that these have been renewed as necessary. Check that the car registration and auto manual are in order and with you. Get traveler's checks and an extra check pad. Also be sure that you have your credit cards with you. And take along an extra car key—and your house key.

Be sure to pack any special medication used by a member of the family—especially prescription drugs. If any family members wear glasses or contact lenses, pack an extra pair—or take along the lens prescription.

Have snacks and picnic with you for on-the-road refreshments and naps. And don't forget to take a litterbag. If you have small children, take along toys and entertainment for long journeys. Finally, pack the items that you'll need along the way in one bag to avoid unloading the entire car each night.

And have a nice vacation!

Maysville gets
EDA grant
for park

Approval of a \$46,000 grant to help develop an industrial park and stimulate long-range economic growth in Mason county, was announced Friday by William W. Blunt Jr., Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Economic Development.

The City of Maysville applied for the grant from the Economic Development Administration, U.S. Department of Commerce.

The project involves the installation of water and sewer facilities to serve the Charleston Botanical Industrial Park owned by the East Kentucky Rural Electric Cooperative.

Maysville and the cooperative are developing the industrial park in connection with the overall economic development program of the Buffalo Trace Economic Development District. The multi-county district organization is working to overcome regional problems blocking growth and to create jobs for residents of economically lagging areas. Maysville is the growth center for the district.

Local officials said that job opportunities expected to be created by firms locating in the industrial park will be open to residents from throughout the district.

Maysville will match the EDA grant to complete the \$90,000 total cost of the project.

Lions Blue Grass Fair

The Lexington Lions Club will host the Lions Blue Grass Fair from July 12 through July 27 in Lexington, at the Red Mile.
