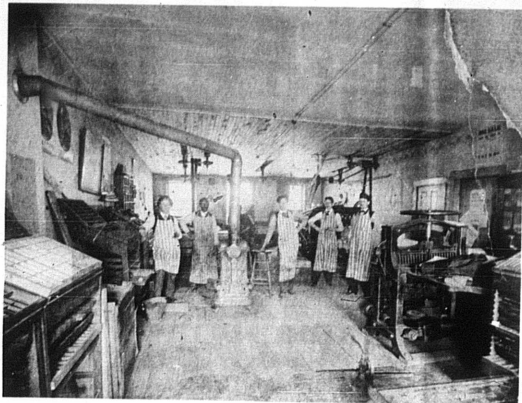


Inside The Carlisle Mercury plant located at corner of Sugartree Alley and S. Locust St.
