In 1960, when there will be about 100 nuclear power plants operating in the United States, there is a chance that one accident at one of them will kill you. Don't plan to live any longer.

Although it is not possible to remove all risk from any nuclear endeavor, a newly released report by the Atomic Energy Commission demonstrates that the probability of a nuclear accident causing 1,000 or more deaths, for example, is about as small as that of a meteor falling on an American city with the same consequences.
