

Preservation Foundation acquires Mary Todd home

FRANKFORT—The Kentucky Mansion's Preservation Foundation has acquired the childhood home of Mary Todd Lincoln in Lexington. The foundation plans to restore the home and create a public shrine.

Mrs. Beula Num, chairman of the foundation, says that "the house will be renovated and restored to the period when Mary Todd Lincoln lived there."

She said that the effort will involve the creation of a strictly Georgian

structure and the acquisition of many of the home's original furnishings.

The foundation was originally created to refurbish the state governor's mansion, and now making efforts to restore many of the state's historic sites.

Their current project is its seventh year and, with the help of various women's clubs across the state, the group was able to raise \$44,000 for the purchase of the home. Mrs. Num
