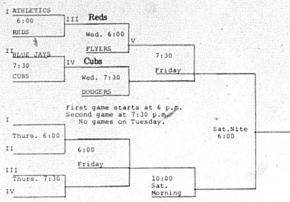

## Garden Field Days at UK July 26-27

Are you interested in vegetables, fruits, flowers, trees, or shrubs? If so, you should plan to visit the Landscape Garden Center at the University of Kentucky during the weekend of July 26-27. These are the dates of this year's Horticulture Field Days, which are sponsored by the UK College of Agriculture.

The Landscape Garden Center is located just south of Cooper Drive in Lexington, and is open to the public throughout the year. However, the Horticulture Field Days come at a time when many of the plants in the center are at their seasonal peak. UK personnel from the Department of Horticulture, Entomology, and Plant Pathology will be on hand from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. during the field days to answer questions about plants and to provide information about the center.

The Nicholas County 14-15 year old All Stars start Monday night in Russell-Flatwoods, 11-8. This game called Nicholas County's play in the 14-15 year old Babe Ruth Seventh District Tournament. The 13-year-old tournament begins Friday, July 25 at Elmer Webb Park in Flatwoods.

## Canoe trips available on scenic Green River

For those who enjoy a different type of outdoor adventure, Greenburg, Ky., has a new canoe rental service which provides up to four days of cruising down scenic Green River. The Green River Canoe Club, a non-profit organization, started the livery the first week in June with 20 aluminum canoes. The immediate response indicates canoeing on the Green River will be very popular. The club provides all transportation and equipment for trips of from two miles to 36 miles, and a once a week three-day Greenburg to Mammoth Cave venture to be organized. Those who just want to experiment on canoeing skills will enjoy paddling at canoe headquarters at the Green County American Legion Park, just outside of Greenburg.

The popular overnight trip is \$12 per paddler. Canoes enter the river below Green River Lake Dam and cruise 36 miles to the Legion Park that day. Paddlers may camp at the park free and continue down the river the next day. Available at no charge are picnic tables, outdoor grills, city water, and limited bathroom facilities. To make hours between canoe trips more enjoyable the park has a swimming pool, lighted tennis courts, 10 horseshoe pits under roof, basketball goals, three softball and baseball diamonds, and two playground equipment for the youngsters. Those under 18 must have a parent sign a waiver of liability before renting a canoe. All rental fees are now used to pay for the canoes and equipment, and in future years will go toward the establishment and operation of recreation facilities at the county park.

## USDA seeks comments on proposals for 1976 feed grain and wheat programs

The U.S. Department of Agriculture recently called for comments on its proposed determination for the 1976 feed grain and wheat programs. The Secretary of Agriculture proposed to make determination and issue regulations relative to: —The National Feed Grain Allotment. The Secretary announced on April 10 that the 1976 wheat allotment would be 61.6 million acres. The Secretary is required to announce the wheat allotment by April 13 of each year for the crop to be harvested in the next calendar year. For feed grain the determination for the 1976 crop must be announced by Dec. 31, 1975. —Whether there should be a set-aside requirement for feed grains and wheat for the 1976 crop and, if so, the extent of such requirement. —The loan rate for the 1976 crop of feed grains and wheat, including commodity eligibility, storage require- ments and loan maturity dates. —Other related provisions necessary to carry out the loan and purchase program and the set-aside program. Prior to making the determinations, considerations will be given to any written comments received by the Director, Grain, Oilseeds, and Cotton Division, Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250, not later than Aug. 4.
