**Blue Grass Fair to hold junior and angus shows**

A feature has been added to the Livestock Division of the Lions Blue Grass Fair which will hold an air of prestige to the Fair... the addition of the Kentucky Junior and Kentucky Angus Association State Shows. The state's "black cattle" organization will be the focus of the move at the invitation of the Fair management. The dates for the Angus shows are Friday, July 18 for the Junior show and Saturday, July 19 for the Angus Open State Show.

Other Livestock Shows scheduled for the 1975 Fair are: Blue Grass Jersey Parish Show—Monday, July 21; 4-H and FFA Dairy Show (Guernsey, Brown Swiss and Ayrshire)—Tuesday, July 22; 4-H and FFA Holstein Show—Wednesday, July 23; 4-H and FFA Sheep Show—Thursday, July 24; Kentucky State Hereford Show—Friday, July 25; 4-H and FFA Beef Show—Saturday, July 26.

A well organized agricultural program is a major factor in promoting a successful Fair. Over 5,000 young people, totally dedicated to their work through programs and goals set forth by leaders in Future Farmers of America and 4-H, participate heavily in the Lions Blue Grass Fair. Youth who plan to participate at the Kentucky State Fair must first qualify at their local county fair if they have one. For those who do not, the Lions Blue Grass Fair serves as a prerequisite for the Kentucky State Fair as a regional fair. These two organizations allow youth from 72 Kentucky counties to be a part of the Fair.
