DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME/FERTILIZER PRODUCTION

When year-round Daylight Saving Time was enacted, I studied on the Senate floor that there was absolutely no assurance that it would save energy—as its proponents contended. Our experiment with year-round DST surprised my contention correct, and Congress shortened DST to eight months a year. Later this year we will again have the opportunity to reduce, the problems and inconveniences remain the same as long as DST is in effect during the winter months. We still have school children standing in the dark waiting for school buses. This is a serious safety hazard and many parents as well as the Kentucky Farm Bureau have registered their complaints with me.

Cattle and hog prices may improve this spring

By Spring, feed cattle prices could rise into the mid-40s, up from January's \$38-43 per 100 pounds, according to a report issued Monday by USDA's Economic Research Service. Cow and feeder cattle prices may also improve, because slaughter will fall as pastures green and farmers move cattle back to grass.
