OFFICIAL NOTICE TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS (REAL ESTATE)

This is to notify all Property Owners that all property has been increased in valuation for tax year 1975. This raise in valuation is in accordance with Kentucky Revised Statutes 132.450 (2).

The only EXCEPTION to this blanket raise is that property purchased in 1973 and 1974 has not been raised.

Valuation of property may be obtained by contacting the Property Valuation Administrator's office, the Courthouse, Carlisle, Kentucky

Any taxpayer aggrieved by their assessment may appeal to the local tax appeals board as provided by KRS 133.120 (1).

A letter or petition stating the reason for appeal shall be filed with the county clerk during the week the tax roll is open for inspection (Jun 2 thru Jun 6) ONLY. Bobby G. Anderson Property Valuation Administrator

INSPECTION PERIOD FOR THE PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENT ROLL

The NICHOLAS County property tax roll will be opened for inspection from June 2 through June 6, 1975. Under the supervision of the property valuation administrator or one of his deputies, any property owner may inspect the tax roll to check the assessment of his property and compare it with the assessment of comparable property to determine whether it is equitably assessed.

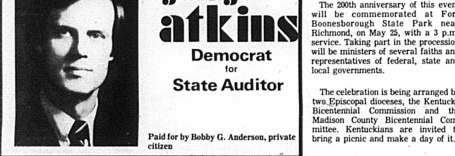
This is the January 1, 1975 assessment on which state, county, and school taxes for 1975 will be due on September 15, 1975.

The tax roll is in the office of the property valuation administrator in the county courthouse and may be inspected between the hours 8:30 A.M. and 4:30 P.M.

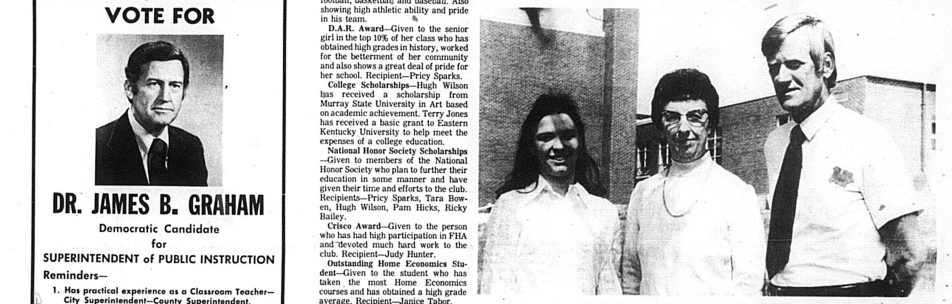
