house flies. They have sponging mouth parts, feeding on mucous secretions around the eyes and nostrils. They will also feed on blood coming from an open wound. Although it has been proven that face flies are a direct cause of pinkeye in cattle, a high correlation between heavy face fly populations and pinkeye has been observed.  
Face flies are difficult to control, since they feed on the head and remain on the animals only a short time each day. The best way to control them is to set up a dust bag in a forced-air circulation—forcing the animals to bump the bag with their heads as they get

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
