Officials change hunting dates

FRANKFORT—P.L. Campbell authorities have informed the Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources of several major changes affecting hunting dates and procedures on that military reservation.

For the Oct. 23-24 hunt, applications must be made before 1 p.m., Oct. 20, and hunters must call between that time and 6 p.m., Oct. 22 to find out if they have been selected and to confirm their reservations.

For deer hunters, the only dates not affected by this change are the opening and closing dates of the first bow hunt—Oct. 10 through Oct. 20. The remainder of the previously announced bow and gun deer hunting dates fall on either a Tuesday or Wednesday, days when hunting is not permitted.

The opening of the gun deer season, for example, was set for Oct. 21—Tuesday. Thus, hunting will not be permitted until Thursday, Oct. 23. A morning, 44,000 had been paid out for the hulled walnuts. Clifton Waghel is in charge of operations, and Arthur Wells stated four men could have worked full time to accommodate the business.

Both gun and bow deer hunters must now take part in a drawing to determine eligibility to hunt and area assignments. This drawing applies only to Oct. 23 and 24 and to weekends.
