### GERALD KEITH GEORGE

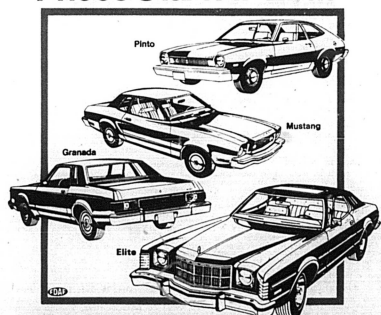

### Public school rolls to decrease, costs up

The U.S. Office of Education predicts that between 1972 and 1982, there will be a drop in public school enrollments from 56.8 million to 45.1 million.
