Kentucky Water Sports

ARE BASS TOURNAMENTS HARMSFUL? [Second of Two Part Series]

The effect of bass tournament fishing is hotly debated among fishermen today. Some state we have four or five states have actually studied the result of tournament fishing pressure. Kentucky is one of those states.

There are 15 fishery biologists in Kentucky's five districts. Their 1974 studies were published in a report of the Department of Fish and Wildlife by Peter W. Pfeiffer, Assistant Director of Fisheries.

The study included the state's 54 bass clubs, three state and two national events. Four hundred thirty-two tournaments were held on all major impoundments with Barkley Lake the most popular with 51 tournaments followed by Barren, Cumberland, Green and Kentucky Lakes.

According to the survey, most club members have low wells, 40 per cent and the members have live well aerators and several clubs give bonus points for fish released alive.

Ninety-five per cent of the clubs have a 12-inch minimum size limit to the state regulation of 10 inches.

The average tournament lasted 14 hours with a total of 102,000 hours of fishing reported.

The average bass caught was 15 inches and weighed 17 pounds. Each angler caught an average of only 10 pounds of bass during 1974 tournament competition.

In another study of Barren Lake in 1974 the biologists found that 29 tournaments yielded a total of one 6-inch bass per 100 acres of water.

"What this means then is that tournament bass fishermen are catching less than four per cent of the total annual harvest by sport fishermen, and less than five per cent of the black bass present," reported Pfeiffer.

The conclusion states, "Based on these data it is apparent that the harvest of black bass by tournament anglers in Kentucky is not, at the present time, great enough to infringe upon the bass harvest by other anglers."

"With the catch and release program practiced by many clubs, which is estimated to have from 25 to 80 per cent success, the significance of tournament fishing pressure is further reduced."

Reports from other states have reached similar conclusions.

Joan Holbrook, a fisheries biologist for the Tennessee Valley Authority, told a recent national bass symposium that "in most large reservoirs national bass tournaments have accounted for less than 4 per cent of the total yearly harvest of bass." Also a survey by the Arkansas Fish and Game Commission found that "tournament fishing does not vary greatly from other types of fishing—it merely displays the results of a tremendous amount of fishing pressure over a very short period of time. The overall catch rate is not significantly higher than other types and represents only a small portion of the annual harvest."

Non-tournament fishermen seem to resent big money tournaments the most.

International Bicentennial Festival Oct. 9-12 at UK

Friday, Oct. 10, has been set aside for Kentucky school children. All children accompanied by a teacher or parent will be admitted for 25 cents between the hours to 10 a.m. from 12 noon to 12 midnight Saturday, Oct. 11; and from 12 noon to 6 p.m. Sunday, Oct. 12.

Admission is \$1 for adults and 50 cents for children. Each money-earning project in the festival is sponsored by a non-profit organization.
