

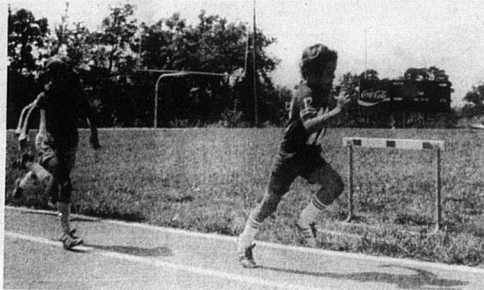
All Stars win Camargo Tourney
