National marketing tobacco quota to be announced soon

The Agricultural Adjustment Act of 1938 provides that the amount of the National Quota for burley tobacco for the 1977-78 marketing year shall be determined and announced no later than Feb. 1, 1977. Details on determinations to be made and the legislative provisions on the determinations were scheduled for publication in the Federal Register Dec. 17.

A meeting will be held to discuss supply and demand and other factors relating to the determinations. It will be held in Lexington, but the exact time and place is yet to be determined. Within 30 days following the announcement of the amount of the National Marketing Quota, burley tobacco growers will hold a referendum to determine if quotas should be in effect for the next three marketing years beginning Oct. 1, 1977. Although the date of the referendum has not been determined, a tentative date of Feb. 24 is being considered.
