Renovating Grass Fields

Grassland renovation is the improvement of pasture and hay fields by partial destruction of the sod, plus liming, fertilizing, and seeding as well as required to establish or re-establish desirable grasses. This is primarily an intervening crop. In Kentucky, this improvement has been primarily through the seeding of legumes such as clovers and alfalfa into grass sods.

Conventional tools may be used to disturb and weaken the grass, prepare a seedbed, sow the legume seed, and cutback in one trip over the field. Conventional tillage tools usually leave the surface rough, but renovation does not change surface roughness.

Moisture and temperature are two important factors in establishing legumes in old grass sod. In the long run, early spring seedings (mid-February through March) are more likely to be successful than late spring or late summer seedings. Alfalfa may be planted from mid-March through April. However, with adequate moisture in August and September, late summer seedings may be successful.

The following five steps are "keys" to successful renovation:

- Graze or mow the grass close prior to renovating. This will tillage tools tear into the sod more easily.
- Do not plant legume seeds into tall grass. The grass shades legume seedlings and reduces their growth.
- Test the soil and apply needed lime, phosphate, and potash. Use fertilizer with boron if alfalfa is to be seeded or red clover is to be grown for seed. For convenience, these materials can be applied ahead of tillage. If possible, lime should be applied several months before renovating. Don't use nitrogen when you renovate old grass fields. Nitrogen increases grass competition to the legume seedlings.
- Disturb 40 to 60 percent of the grass for sowing clovers, 80 to 100 percent for alfalfa. This tillage helps control grass growth and open a seedbed for the legume.
- Legumes will have a better chance to germinate and live. A disk, field cultivator, or field tiller will do a good job.
