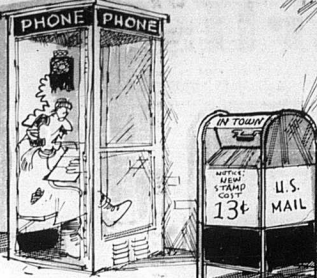

FRANKFORT—A bill recently prepared for the upcoming General Assembly has disclosed that Kentucky apparently does not have a reckless driving law.

Under the bill drafted by Mason and Hancock, any person who drives any vehicle in willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property would be judged guilty of reckless (rather than careless) driving and the maximum fine for the first offense would be raised from \$100 to \$500.
