Congress asks Corps study of Red River Lake alternatives

Congress has directed the Corps of Engineers to take a new look at flood control and water supply alternatives to the Red River Lake.

Col. Ellis said the study has begun, but added, "I want to emphasize that this is not another look at the Red River Lake project. It is an investigation to find ways to solve flood problems at Clay City and Stanton and water supply needs in the Kentucky River Basin.

He explained that the Corps will look into such flood control alternatives as levees, channel improvements, small impoundments, or retarding structures, evacuation and flood proofing methods.

The Corps will submit technical reports to Congress at the conclusion of the study—one on flood control and the other on water supply alternatives. The study will take about one year, Colonel Ellis said.
