"Now, I'd say we have less than 100 cases in our court today to dispose of. We're almost current. People are getting their cases decided much more promptly than they used to," Justice Palmero said.

Justice Palmero said the additional judges in the appellate system are largely responsible for easing the backlog. He noted that the Court of Appeals meets in three-judge panels across the state, which added speed to the system. "We actually have three times the people (judges) to do the work," he said.

He added that the number of judges on the Court of Appeals can be expanded if the caseload shows the need for more judges.

Justice Palmero said the number of district courts is also an advantage. "There are 113 district judges, he said, whereas the number of judges in police, county quarterly and magisterial courts is more than 700.

Justice Palmero said the new court system will probably cost more than the old system, since there was a new Court of Appeals and the district court judges' salaries of \$27,300 each, but, he said, the speed efficiency of the new courts would make them "well worth the expense."

Justice Palmero said problems and disadvantages of the new system involved increased administrative duties of the Supreme Court chief justice, which often prevent the chief justice from participating in the writing of decisions. Also, district courts have had trouble finding facility space in some counties, he said, and will probably experience problems in the transition from the old system to the new. But Justice Palmero predicted the district court problems would solve themselves within two years after they begin operation.

Optimist basketball contest set Dec. 17
