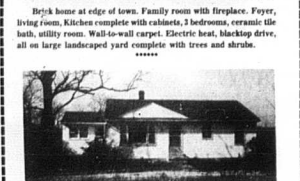

All gifts will be recorded and acknowledgments made to the family.

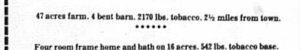

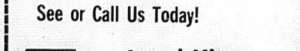

## Agricultural workers to earn minimum wage

As of Jan. 1, 1978, agricultural workers covered by the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) will, for the first time, receive the same minimum wage—\$2.30 an hour—as other categories of covered workers, according to James K. Paiching, regional employment standards administrator, U.S. Department of Labor, Atlanta.

The 1978 amendments to the FLSA also provide for additional increases in the minimum wage for all covered workers through 1981—\$2.90 an hour beginning Jan. 1, 1979; \$3.10 an hour, Jan. 1, 1980; and \$3.30 an hour, Jan. 1, 1981.

In order to be covered by the FLSA, an agricultural employer must work for an employer who used more than 500 man-days of agricultural labor in any calendar quarter of the preceding calendar year.

The child labor provisions of the FLSA prohibit the employment of minors under 16 years of age in agriculture during school hours and in occupations declared hazardous.

Minors under 18 years of age may not be employed in agriculture at any time except for: (1) minors under 12 who work on farms owned and operated by their parents or with parental consent on farms not covered by the minimum wage act; (2) minors 12 and 13 who work on any farm with written parental consent or on farms where parents are employed.

The 1977 FLSA amendments provide that an employer may apply to the secretary of labor for a waiver permitting employment of minors 16 and 17 years of age as hand harvest laborers, if the waiver is granted, such minors may be employed for not more than eight weeks between June 1 and Oct. 15 of any calendar year. The waiver does not affect the minimum wage requirement.

Employers are required to obtain proof of age from employees. A fine up to \$1,000 may be imposed for each violation of the child labor provisions of the Act.

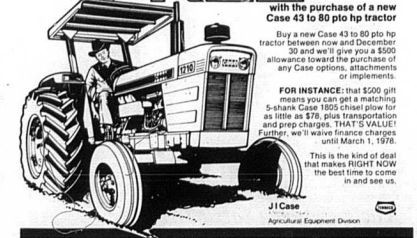

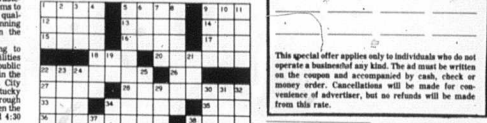

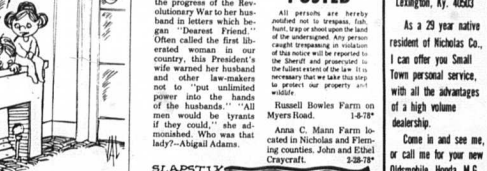
