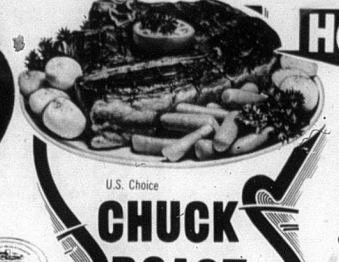
McClure child has birthday
